

Afghanistan Reform Programmes

Landlocked and mountainous, Afghanistan has suffered from such chronic instability and conflict during its modern history that its economy and infrastructure are in ruins, and many of its people are refugees.

From 2007 to 2011 Charles Kendall supported an ambitious procurement reform programme in Afghanistan funded by the World Bank.

Our work ensured the successful design and implementation of a sustainable nationwide procurement capacity building strategy for the central government, provincial and municipal government and the private sector.

We also instituted a new procurement law including development of a web-based procurement management information system and recommendations for an e-procurement environment, an improved legal and institutional framework including an effective regulatory body and review mechanism with a view to securing the implementation of new Public Procurement Law.
