Security in the Supply Chain

Many countries are implementing customs regimes, border controls and supply chain security programs to meet the ever increasing threat of global terrorism and smuggling. In June 2005 the WCO Council adopted the SAFE Framework of Standards to secure and facilitate global trade and act as a deterrent to international terrorism, secure revenue collections and promote trade worldwide. Increasingly, countries are adopting the SAFE framework standards into their own customs regimes. C-TPAT, AEO, PIP, Frontline and SEP all utilize the same SAFE framework standards from the WCO.
